WHO MAY BE ELIGIBLE?



Those who have an active eviction filing with the Magisterial District Courts or Allegheny County Court of Common Pleas



Those who have a completed Mediation Agreement with their landlord through Just Mediation Pittsburgh

THINGS WE MAY ASK YOU FOR

- Income verification, such as paystubs or benefits letters
- Birth certificates and/or Social Security Cards for all household members
- Eviction docket
- Lease

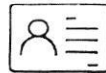
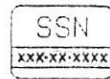


Photo ID for all adults in the household



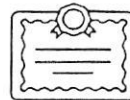
Income verification, like paystubs or benefits letters
